**Detail:** A bust of Shakespeare surmounting a cartouche in which is inscribed DAVID GARRICK. The cartouche surrounded by garlands, containing dramatic masks, cornucopia, bows and arrows, and at the base, a lyre, bell and dagger. In the mantling on the left 'I Wood ingids'.[?]
