Indorsement

Memorandum that before the Execution of he within Ind[enture] it was agreed by 7 between the parties thereto that the within named Eva Maria Violette, from & after her Marriage with he within named David Garrick and notwithstanding thereof all & singular the Jewels & ornaments of her person which she now hath or which hereafter shall be presented to her shall keep possess & enjoy to & for her own sole 7 separate use for ever no wise subject to the debts power or comptroll of her said intended Husband nor in case of his death before her to be deemed Assetts of his personal Estate
