Transcript: Leamington

Sir,

On my arrival here last Evening I found your letter for which I am very much obliged I will be Thankful if you will send me the letters here in packet not Exceeding three fourths of an ounce Each and to do the same by any others that you may find for the next three weeks only you May find after that I will be thankful

Reverse: to you to direct to me in the same way to Nannau near Dolgellau N[orth] W[ales] where I shall be most happy to see you should any thing bring you to North Wales
