**Transcript:**

Mr Garrick died on Jan 20<sup>th</sup> 1779.

M<sup>rs</sup> Garrick went to M<sup>rs</sup> Rackett on the 27<sup>th</sup>

The Funeral took place on the 1<sup>st</sup> of Feb[ruar]y.

M<sup>rs</sup> Garrick returned home on the evening of the 3<sup>d</sup> Feb[ruar]y.

She went to Hampton, accompanied by Wallis, my mother & my self etc on the 7<sup>th</sup>, where she stayed till the 13<sup>th</sup>.

The inventory was taken on the 18<sup>th</sup>, & 5 following days
