Annotated: Messrs Panchauds Letter & Acc[oun]t of the East India Annuity b[ough]t in 1771

By Mo[n]s[ieu]r Panchaud's Letter of ye 20 June 1771 it appears that they had bought an annuity for the life of M^{rs} G[arrick] of 1200 Livres from the French India Company, of which one year w[oul]d become due the 1st of July following

That he desired M^r G[arrick]s Letter of attorney & a certificate of M^{rs} G[arrick]s life,

That by an Arrest of y^e Council of the 10 June the said annuity was subjected to a deduction of 10 per cent for the King so that the amount for the future would be but 1080 Livres instead of 1200

By another Letter of the 12 of Sept[ember] 1771 It appears he sent M^{rs} G[arrick] a notorial Copy of the Contract for the said annuity

By [another letter] of the 10 January 1774 and the Amount therein transmitted

It appears that the Annuity had been renewed to the 1st July 1773 and that Mo[n]s[ieu]r Panchaud then drew on M^r G[arrick] for 82li 1 : 9 Sterling (being 1929 Livres) for the Ballance then due to them

So that (according to my Computation) there was on y^e 1st July 1779 due of the said Annuity 6 y[ea]rs at 1079^{Liv} - 8 -0 per annum - -al money received, amounting to 6476^{Liv} : 8
