Madame de Saar: Mrs Garrick's niece, Elizabeth Fürst, came to stay with the Garricks in September 1777. Osborn, 'Literary material', 120, 123. *Letters*, 1134, 1149, 1184, 1234, 1243? Letter to: 1151. Garrick left her £1,000 in his will. *Letter* 1134 n3: 'Elisabeth (Liserl) Fürst (1766 – 1840), daughter of Peter Fürst, a retired Viennese municipal inspector, and Therese, Mrs Garrick's sister came to London to live with her aunt in June 1777 ... after the death of Garrick ... she returned to Vienna and on July 2, 1781, married Joseph Peter Adam von Saar (1762-1830), Imperial Royal Councillor of Finance in the Austrian postal service...'
